The journal is one of the premier forums in Australia for the publication and circulation of peer-reviewed, high-quality historical scholarship. It also carries lively reviews of new books and public exhibitions ('History off the Page'). History Australia is currently published quarterly, in print and online, by Taylor & Francis.

The current outstanding editorial team from the Australian Catholic University—Kate Fullagar, Ben Mountford, Ellen Warne and Jessica Lake—complete their term in 2024. The new editorial team will need to be in place by mid-2024. The AHA Executive welcomes expressions of interest from candidates located in any Australian university or universities, and engaged in any variety of history, to be received by **Friday 17 November 2023.**

Expressions of interest should include:

- A brief outline of ideas on the future direction of the journal;
- Evidence of the level of support in terms of administrative assistance and, where relevant, teaching relief to be provided by the new editor or editorial team's home institution(s).
- A brief CV (one page max) for each member of the proposed team, including previous editorial or organisational experience and research strengths.
